

St. Anne's-Belfield School

Grades 5 - 8 Start Times, Early Morning Care, and After School Care

Arrival

- Middle School students (Grades 5-8) should use the main Middle School entrance for arrival.
- Middle School classrooms open at **7:50 a.m.** and start time is at **8:15 a.m.**
- Early Morning Care is available at **7:30 a.m.** free of charge for 5 - 8 families who need to drop off students before classrooms open. Early Morning Care meets in the 5/6 Commons.
- Please do not drop students off prior to **7:30 a.m.** as the building will be locked.

Dismissal

- Middle School dismissals are facilitated by the PikMyKid app. Grades 5-6 dismiss from the main Middle School entrance, and Grades 7-8 dismiss to the CCC Circle.
- Middle School students are invited to dismiss from their youngest K-8 sibling's dismissal location. Middle School students who need to dismiss with siblings in the Lower School will be expected to remain in their dismissal classrooms until **3 p.m.** At this point, they will report to the Legner Library to await Lower School dismissal. Students may not be unsupervised in the building between dismissals.
- Dismissal times vary by grade level:
 - Grades K - 4: **3:15 p.m.**
 - Grades 5 - 6: **2:45 p.m.**
 - Grades 7 & 8 (participating in Athletics): **4:10 p.m.** (Monday-Thursday) and **2:45 pm** on Friday
 - Grades 7 & 8 (in Non-School Sponsored Activity): **2:45 p.m.**
- Students who are not picked up within twenty minutes of the start of dismissal will join **Saints After School (SAS)**.

Saints After School (formerly ASEP)

Saints After School (SAS) for students in Grades K - 8 takes place in the Learning Village building from dismissal until **5:30 p.m.** The program will be operational the first day of school and each day thereafter on which regular classes meet, as well as the last day of school.
