

WHY SHOULD I JOIN THE ARTS BOOSTERS?

Q: What is the purpose of the Arts Boosters?

A: The Arts Boosters is a parent-run fundraising and volunteer organization that enhances arts programming within all divisions at St. Anne's-Belfield.

Q: How do I become a member of the Arts Boosters?

A: Make a contribution of \$25 or more.

Q: How has the Arts Boosters enhanced the arts at St. Anne's?

A: We funded an **artist-in-residence**, John Rubino, who collaboratively built the sculpture next to the Learning Village Dining Hall with students; we funded **guest artist** Peter Gould, a clown and mime expert, who helped author last year's sixth grade play; we funded the commission of a **children's opera** "Full Circle," which premiered at St. Anne's-Belfield in 2016 and was performed again in 2019; we provided additional funds for teachers to spend on **classroom materials**; and we provided extra funds to support the annual Upper School **musical**.

Q: How can I volunteer my time with the Arts Boosters?

A: There are many ways!

- Attend meetings to plan arts events, fundraisers, and distribute funds.
- Provide baked goods or snack items for Middle & Upper School plays
- Host a concession table during intermission of Middle & Upper School plays
- Help with logistics for the Fine Arts Concert & Runway Show
- Coordinate Registration and/or Food for the annual Upper School A Capella Fest
- Help with logistics for our annual Spring Plant Sale fundraiser
- Sign up for a shift to distribute plants at the plant sale
