Grades 9 - 12 Uniform Dress Code

The St. Anne's-Belfield School uniform dress code deepens our sense of community while allowing students the freedom to focus on their passions and pursuits.

Ways to Purchase Uniforms:

- **Lands' End** [custom website](#) for St. Anne's-Belfield School that provides an interface to browse and purchase clothing items that have been approved by the School.
 - It is available all year, so families may purchase items as children grow and as the seasons change.

- The Parents' Association (PA) operates **Saints' Closet**, a gently-used uniform sale in late summer and throughout the year starting in September.
 - Donations and consignments are being accepted in the gray bin in divisional offices through July 31.

 - The PA will pay out at 30% of the sale price upfront for all "very good condition" consignment designated items. Items donated (not consigned) return 100% of proceeds to the Parents' Association to support its programming and initiatives.

Grades 9 - 12 Uniform Dress Code Requirements

- Dress code-approved clothing options appear on the St. Anne's-Belfield page of the Lands' End website. Clothing worn at School must be part of the School color palette: maroon, white, black, gray.
- Students may elect to have Lands' End print the School seal on many of the items, but doing so is not a requirement.
- Students are not required to have any particular items, and are not required to have all of these items.
- Students may only wear sweatshirts, sweaters and blazers that have been purchased either from Lands' End or the School Store or provided by a School athletic team. Not permitted: Flannel shirts, non-School sweatshirts or any kind of layer that is not maroon, white, black, or gray.
- Jackets and outerwear need not be purchased from Lands' End, but such attire may not be worn inside buildings during the school day.
- Students do not need to tuck in polo shirts. If they choose to wear a button down-type oxford shirt, they are required to wear a belt and keep their shirts tucked in at all times.
- All shoes should be closed-toe and have a back. Sneakers or shoes may be worn.
- No flip-flops or other "pool" or "beach" shoes — shoes made of plastic or with rubber straps — are to be worn.
- No shoes with wheels may be worn.

St. Anne's-Belfield School

When students attend Chapel in-person (TBD based on 2021-22 Covid mitigation)

- All clothes are to be clean and in good repair.
- Girls should wear dresses, skirts, or dress slacks that are appropriate for a business-type event.
- Boys should wear dress shirts that are tucked in with a belt and tie.
- Dress code-approved sweatshirts, sweaters or blazers are permitted. See above.

Blue Denim Days

- Students may wear a dress code-appropriate top with jeans of their choosing that are in good condition without holes or tears. No jeans shorts or jean skirts.
- In the Upper School, Blue Denim Days are every Thursday, unless otherwise announced
