MEAL OFFERINGS BY DIVISION

LEARNING VILLAGE GRADES K - 4

1. Pre-Paid Meal Plan: \$840 (includes weekly Community Meals)

The students are provided a freshly made, well-balanced meal. There is no fried food offered, and we provide a nut-free kitchen (however we cannot control what other parents pack in their children's lunches). Many of our fruits and vegetables and proteins are sustainably raised by local farmers.

2. Community Meal Pre-Paid Plan: \$165

It is our desire at St. Anne's-Belfield to strengthen the sense of Community through the commitment to our weekly "Community Meal," a time where students and faculty share a family style meal and fellowship.

For those parents who do not desire to purchase a comprehensive Pre-Paid Meal Plan, but do want their child to fully enjoy the weekly community meal by eating the School-provided meal, we offer a Community Meal Pre-Paid Plan. For only \$165, your child will always be able to eat this specially planned and prepared School meal.

3. A la carte

Students can elect to sign up each morning for the School meal. The average cost of the daily a la carte lunch for Grades K - 4 is \$6.50. A cafeteria account is set up for every student. We request that you pre-fund their account through myschoolbucks.com. Their cafeteria account can also be funded by check given to the division office or the business office. Charges are made to their accounts when the orders are placed in the mornings with their teachers. Please do not send cash with young students.

LEARNING VILLAGE GRADES 5 - 8

1. Pre-Paid Meal Plan: \$925 (includes weekly Community Meals)

Lunches include choices such as soup and salad bar, deli sandwich selection, vegetarian entrée, and a hot meal entrée choice. We offer a variety of juices, skim, and 2% milk. The Pre-Paid Meal Plan includes a nutritious snack at mid-morning break. Most of our mid-morning snacks are homemade and can be any of the following: homemade muffins, breakfast biscuits, cereal, granola bars, yogurt, and fruit.

2. Community Meal Pre-Paid Plan: \$165 (Mandatory for all Grades 5 - 8 students not on the Pre-Paid Plan)

It is our desire at St. Anne's-Belfield to strengthen the sense of Community through the commitment to our weekly "Community Meal." In all divisions, the "Community Meal" is a time where students and faculty share a family style meal and discussions of the week's events.

3. A la carte

Students in Grades 5 - 8 can purchase individual items or full meals on a daily basis. The average cost of the daily mid-morning snack is \$3.25 and average cost of an a la carte lunch is \$7.00 depending on combination of their choices. A cafeteria account is set up for every student. We request that you pre-fund their account through myschoolbucks.com. Their cafeteria account can also be funded by check given to the division office, the business office or the lunch line attendant. Please do not send cash with students.

UPPER SCHOOL GRADES 9 - 12

1. All Inclusive Meal Plan: \$925 (Mandatory for all Upper School students)

In addition to a mid-morning snack during advisory, our students are offered a soup and salad bar, sandwich deli bar, hot entrée (which includes protein, vegetable, and starch), and vegetarian entrée. "Weekly Standards" include: simple grilled chicken sandwich, pizza day, hand-cut and breaded chicken fingers, and hamburgers made from locally raised beef, all to be served with the vegetable and starch of the day.

FUNDING CAFETERIA ACCOUNTS

Make it easy for your child/ren — set-up and activate a debit account

Cafeteria accounts must have money in them to be activated. You can pre-fund your child/ren's account before the first day of school or any time throughout the year in the following two ways:

- Credit card payment online: myschoolbucks.com
- Check payment made out to St. Anne's-Belfield Dining Services and given to the business office, division office, or handed to the lunch line attendant (Learning Village Grades 5 - 8 only). If you chose to send in checks, a [myschoolbucks](http://myschoolbucks.com) account is not needed.

Please note that accounts must have a positive balance to be used by your child/ren. Notices of low balances or negative balances will be sent to the email address provided in Veracross.

Myschoolbucks accounts (myschoolbucks.com) can be monitored online to review funding and balances.
